Child & Family Resources, founded in 1972, is a private, non-profit child care resource and referral organization that provides a variety of services to children, families, child care professionals, and employers.



Getting Started Is Easy

Becoming a registered provider will help you improve your services to children as well as make you eligible for free referrals and technical assistance. Attend an orientation session and learn more about the registration process. If you live in Morris County and are interested in becoming a registered provider, please contact Child & Family Resources at 973-398-1730.

You'll be surprised at how easy it is to get started. It takes love and concern for children, a safe home, attendance at a provider pre-service training and completed paperwork. Child & Family Resources offers the required pre-service training session of 8 hours. It is divided into two parts: Part 1 (lasting 2 hours) will walk you through the application process, the requirements for the home health/safety inspection, help you understand the registration system and its requirements, such as the number and ages of children and the required paperwork. Part 2 (lasting 6 hours) will complete the training covering topics of child development, curriculum, guiding behavior, inclusion, health/safety, nutrition, and working with parents.

As a professional family child care provider, you'll not only help children feel happy and secure, but you'll have the convenience of working at home and the satisfaction of earning a good income. Family child care takes place in a private home with no more than five children enrolled. New Jersey law allows for voluntary registration. The registration process includes an application process, eight-hour pre-service training and a home health and safety review. Providers must be at least 18 years old.
